Call to Order- The meeting was called to order at 7:02pm

Introductions- introductions were made, small crowd tonight!

**Guest Speaker: Deputy Chief Stephen Haffner** joined us for a great, down to earth chat about all concerns and questions related to public safety in our area. The Neighborhood Liaison Officer program has lots of holes to fill. Program is harder to fill with older officers but DC Haffner advised a new class of 24 officers was incoming. DC Haffner gave us a great breakdown of how the City is staffed with officers. The SW quadrant has 4 districts with 2 officers each. Officers can move to new districts/shifts/quadrants/divisions which can create revolving door or spots to fill in the NLO program. We talked about successes and how residents can help our FWPD. Detectives working with technology have made a major difference in crime solve rate. Cameras such as Ring or Nest are essential. There is a program to connect with the City to provide camera footage if an issue occurs outside your property. Dan Swartz will look into contacting Ring, Nest etc to see if there are any group deals. DC Haffner also advised that now that recruiting has helped to get closer to a fully staffed force that now is a good time to revisit discussion of traffic unit that our citizens have asked about. Traffic calming is a major issue/concerns in all PAPA neighborhoods. PAPA will reach out to our respective members to garner support for the idea to see if we can partner to help move this forward.
